4.1. Group division will occur after the weigh-in. If there are less than three athletes in a weight category, it will be merged. The decision will be made by the Latvian Judo Federation.

4.2. Only athletes who have not participated in any EJU and IJF tournaments in the last two years (except for Veteran competitions) are eligible to participate.

4.3. Registered judokas of the LDF with a qualification not lower than 4.KYU may participate. Only clubs and sports schools that have fulfilled all financial obligations to the LDF may participate.

Entry fee 30.00 EUR (thirty euros).

5. WEIGHT CATEGORIES

Women: -48, -52, -57, -63, -70, -78, +78kg

Men: -60, -66, -73, -81, -90, -100, +100kg

6. WEIGH-IN

The official weigh-in takes place the day before the competition and on the competition day at the specified times (see program). Competitors must present an identity document (passport or ID card). Participants who miss the weigh-in cannot participate in the competition. Official weigh-in is only allowed once.

7. REGISTRATION

Registration for the competition takes place in the LDF electronic system (<http://sportists.info/judo/login.php>) until Friday, January 11, at 23:00.

8. DRAW

The draw will take place on the day of the competition, immediately after the official weigh-in.

9. COMPETITION RULES

Fight duration M1/F1 to M6/F6 3 minutes and unlimited Golden Score.

Competition system:

2-5 participants round-robin system;

6-7 round-robin system with two subgroups;

8 and more participants double-elimination system with consolation (from the semifinalist).

LDF Judges' Commission (TK)

The GT of the Competition does not accept submissions.

GT can consult referees in unclear situations.

All submissions (in written form) by club representatives can be submitted to the LDF TK for consideration after the competition.

Participants bear full responsibility for their health. GT and TK strictly control competition etiquette, discipline, hygiene, and procedure compliance with judo requirements. GT may prohibit further participation in the competition to the offender and the team without prior warning or consultation.

10. JUDOGI CONTROL

White judogi is mandatory in competitions. Judogi criteria according to Sokuteiki rules.

11. AWARDS

Winners and place winners will be awarded medals and diplomas.
